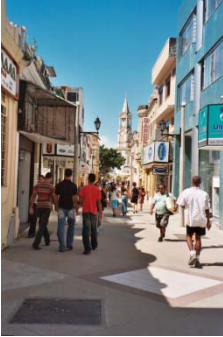


*Globalization: Socio-economic, Political, and Environmental Interdependence, U.S.-Brazil  
Global Education - Spring-Summer-Fall 2012.*



Become a globally engaged citizen! Participate in genuine global education with students from the U.S. and Brazil! Become immersed in a new culture! Learn a foreign language! Travel to exotic places!

Scholarships now available for advanced undergraduate students to participate in the 2012 joint U.S. and Brazil global education program. This new and innovative program, jointly created and administered by faculty at Michigan State University (MSU), Kansas State University (KSU), the Federal University of Bahia (UFBA), and the Federal University of Pará (UFPA), is designed to help faculty and students rise to the challenge of understanding our globalizing world, with its many impacts on environment and society. The one year program entails six integrated components, bringing together foreign language training, research opportunities, and a multidisciplinary curriculum co-taught by faculty from across the partners. The program includes an array of courses that can be counted toward requirements of majors in Geography, majors and specializations in James Madison College, majors in the College of Social Science, and for the MSU specialization in Latin American and Caribbean Studies. The courses can also be applied to electives in various programs, please consult the program webpage.

The scholarship provides a generous stipend for Portuguese language training in Spring 2012 at MSU, and foreign travel from June 20 to August 19<sup>th</sup> to Salvador da Bahia, the historic seat of colonial Brazil - nicknamed the Capital da Alegria (happiness), and Belém do Pará, the metropolis at the mouth of the Amazon. - Curriculum Vita (Resume)
- Unofficial Transcripts
- 3 Recommendation letters

An interview will be scheduled with applicants, once all applications have been reviewed. Before final award, scholarship recipients will be required to apply through the Office of Study Abroad at MSU.
