Upon application, students will be billed a \$100 fee through their MSU account. If accepted, students will be asked to commit to their place on the program. At the time of commitment, they will be billed a \$200 commitment deposit. That total of \$300 is non-refundable. Additional fees may apply if students withdraw after commitment, following the scale detailed above.
